### HAVE YOU HEARD?

Catholics often come from a legalistic attitude toward Mass  
**How late can I come to Mass and still have it count???**

When we gather for Sunday Mass it is important that we reflect on what we believe about our presence.

We believe that each person in the assembly is important.  
We believe that each has a role to play.

We believe that each has a contribution to make for the good of the whole assembly.

If we arrive on time we can be better prepared to hear God speak to us.  
If we arrive late, we are a distraction to others who are already in the pews.

Concert halls will not allow people to enter after the performance has started.  
It has to be just as important at Mass, in order to avoid disturbing those in prayer.

At concerts events we also stay until the end because it would be rude and disruptive to leave early.

Our communion procedure, announcements, blessing and dismissal are all part of our Eucharistic celebration and prayer.

### **Gluten Free Hosts**

Bishop Michael Driscoll has given us permission to offer gluten free hosts to those who cannot receive wheat due to medical reasons. Starting July 17-18, consecrated Gluten Free Hosts will be offered during Communion, by the Deacon in a separate line in front of the Ambo. For those who need to receive these hosts, please be seated on this side of the Church, when these hosts have been distributed the Deacon will return to the Altar to continue distribution of the consecrated wheat hosts.

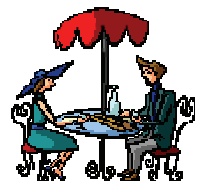
