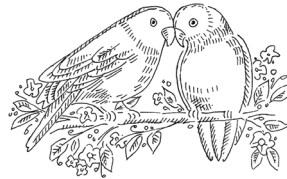

The Food Bank will be closed Monday, July 4, in honor of Independence Day.

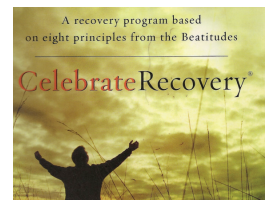
