## Baptism Class

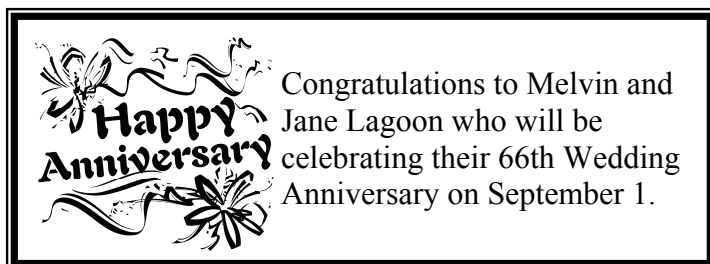
**Saturday, September 10 ,**

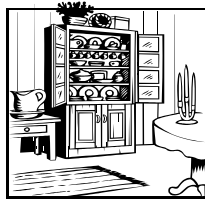
