New Adorers—Thank You!

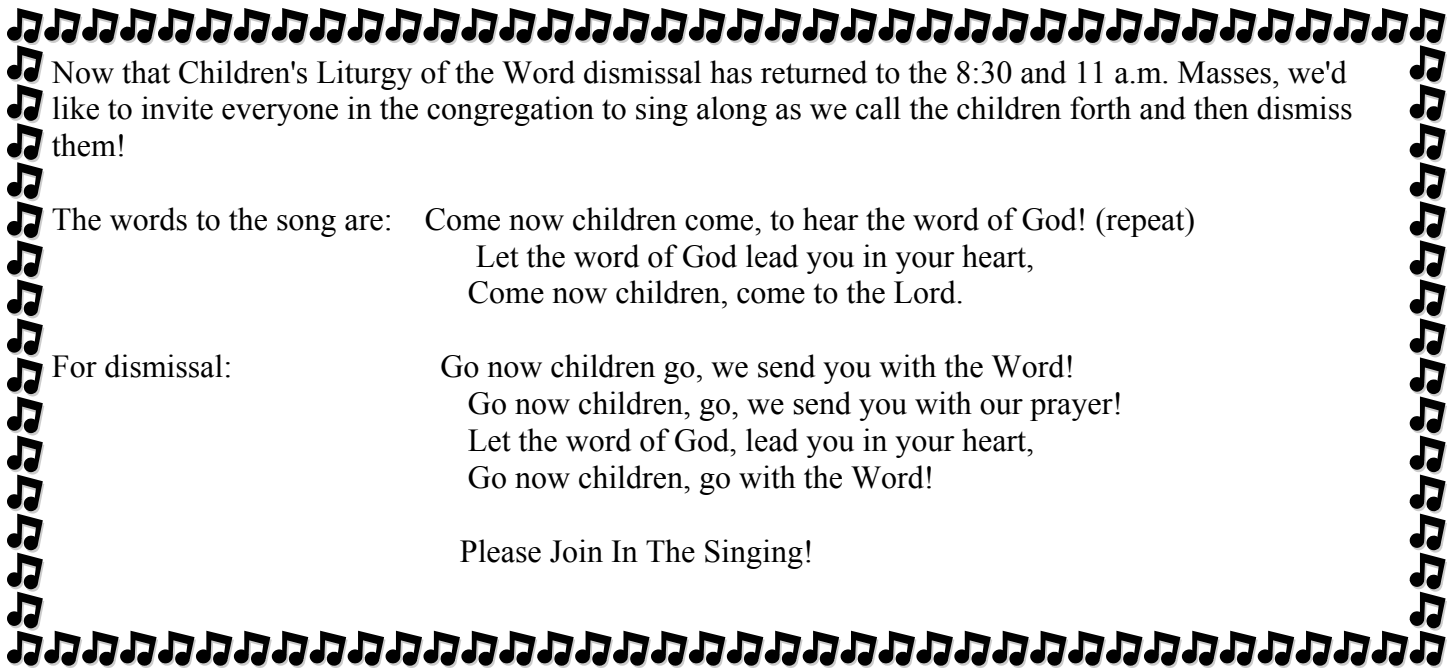
